



TOWARDS ODF PLUS URBAN ANDHRA PRADESH FAECAL SLUDGE AND SEPTAGE MANAGEMENT (FSSM)

Government of Andhra Pradesh has introduced G.O.134 "Faecal Sludge & Septage Management (FSSM) Policy and Operational Guidelines" on March 31st 2017. It requires all Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) to regulate design and periodic cleaning of on-site containment (septic tanks /Pits), septage transport, treatment, re-use and disposal.

The Components of the G.O are:

CONTAINMENT: Design of Sanitary Latrines/Insanitary to Sanitary latrines

COLLECTION & STORAGE: Periodic desludging /schedule monitoring

EMPTYING: Licensing of desludging operators, Monitoring usage of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

TRANSPORTATION: GPS tracking and FSM Tracker mobile app for monitoring

TREATMENT, DISPOSAL AND REUSE : Establishment of faecal sludge treatment plants.

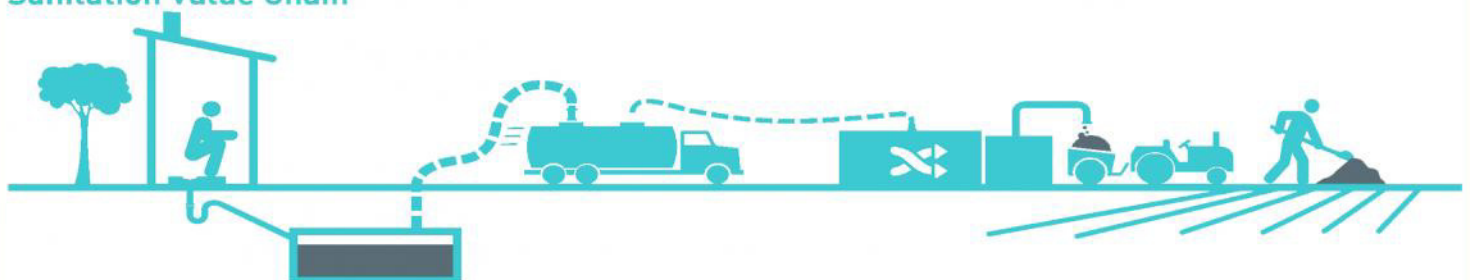
