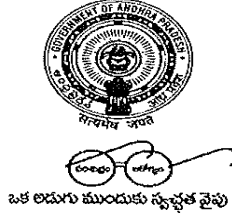

The Ministry of Home Affairs, GOI has granted IDF OI, exemption from the provisions of FCRA 2010 which enables it to receive funding from overseas Indians based in foreign countries.

In this connection, State Governments are requested to identify projects within the range of Rs.2 lakhs to Rs.50 lakhs. A list of such projects can be sent to IDF-OI along with specific location of the project, budget outlay, timelines and implementation agency.

Once we submit the information (as per attached template), the Ministry of Overseas Indian Affairs will project them to the Overseas Indians through their outreach networks. The Overseas Indians can send their contributions for these projects through IDF-OI. State Governments may kindly note that overseas Indians are keen to contribute to specific projects, and see the tangible outcome and results of their financial contribution. They also expect to receive regular feedback and reports about the progress of implementation of projects they have funded.

Hence the commissioners of all ULBs are requested to send the proposals of such projects as per the template enclosed to Swachha Andhra Corporation for onward submission to the GOI for sanction of the projects.

Project Template for submission of projects to IDF-OI

- a) Project Title
- b) Aim of the Project
- c) Short justification for the project
- d) Whether existing or new project
- e) Sector
- e) Implementing agency and NGOs associated
- f) Target beneficiaries- number and nature (eg women, children, tribal etc)
- g) Target geographic location (village, district etc)
- h) Design of project (methodology, intervention etc)
- i) Expected outcomes/ benefits proposed
- j) Project timeline (Date of commencement and completion)
- k) Estimated budget (Should be within the range of Rs Two lakhs to Twenty lakhs only)
- l) Whether the cost includes capital cost as well as maintenance cost
- m) Images of proposed project (If any)

All projects have to adhere to the common essential requirements before it shall be accepted by IDF-OI:

- i) Project with identified budget outlay
- ii) Project timelines with important milestones
- iii) Implementing agency should have been identified
- iv) Photographs of the project site/ existing conditions
- v) Feedback/ Progress reports with photographs (quarterly basis)
- vi) Financial reporting: Fund utilization vis-à-vis project objectives/outcomes
