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Attention is invited to the subject and reference cited.

Vide reference cited, the Member Secretary of APPCB has informed that the C&D Waste Management Rules, 2016 notified by Govt, of India in the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change. The duties/ responsibilities of all the concerned Departments conferred under the provisions of these Rules were communicated by the Board, vide ref. 211d cited.

The Present status and observations made in respect of C&D Waste Management in the State of AP are as follows:

- C&D waste is not being segregated and is being disposed along With Municipal Solid Waste in the existing landfill facilities.
- C&D waste is being disposed on either side of public roads, open places and is being disposed along the irrigation / drainage canal bunds
- Indiscriminate disposal of C&D waste causing public nuisance and choking of irrigation / drainage channels.
- As per the information furnished by the MA&UD Dept., 3 No of C&D Waste Processing & Disposal facilities are proposed in 3 NO of ULBs Viz., Visakhapatnam, Vijayawada & Tirupati.
- Board issued CFE to one C&D Waste Processing plant at Vijayawada on 06.03.2018. State Policy is not yet prepared
- ULBs have not provided storage facilities for C&D waste

As per Rule 5 Of C&D Rules, service providers viz., Municipal bodies, AP Transco, R&B, Phone companies, NHAI shall prepare a waste management plan and shall remove all C&D waste generated by them every day.

It is to clarify that the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, New Delhi is reviewing the 1plementation status of C&D Waste Management Rules, 2016 in GA No. 606 of 2018 and to is effect a Regional Monitoring Committee was constituted by Hon'ble NGT to review every month.

In View of the above, all the concerned authorities are hereby requested to take necessary corrective measures as applicable, with immediate effect in respect of C&D Waste management. The local bodies are requested to monitor the

C&D waste generators and to collect comprehensive waste management plan and consolidate the information to furnish annual reports to the board in Form-III on or before 30th June of every year.

Therefore, it is requested to expedite the process of establishing mechanism for collection, transportation, reuse, recycling & storage of segregated C&D waste, at the earliest. The ULBs shall dispose C&D Waste to Authorized processing and disposal facilities. The facilities shall obtain the CFE, CFO & Authorization of the Board for all such Processing and Disposal facilities before starting operations.

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
