Swachh Andhra Corporation – Proposal for acceding administration sanction for purchase of Solid Waste Management Vehicles, Sweeping Machines & Compactors for 110 ULBs and also constitution of Technical & Tender approval committee – Orders – Issued.

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## **ORDER:**

While forwarding the letter read above, the Managing Director, Swachh Andhra Corporation has stated that the Director of Municipal Administration, Andhra Pradesh informed that in the recently concluded Collector's conference it has been decided to engage Mechanical Sweepers on outsourcing basis in all Municipal Corporations(14), Selection Grade(4) and Special Grade(7) Municipalities and issued instructions to the ULBs. But it could not be materialized due to cost and other reasons. It is decided to procure Mechanical Sweepers for the ULBs. In this context the PMU set up for implementation of G.O.Ms.279 has assessed that in the following 12 ULBs the Mechanical Sweeping is viable and gave number of Mechanical Sweeping Machines for each ULB as shown below:

He has also stated that the Director of Municipal Administration, Andhra Pradesh informed that in the recently concluded Collector's conference it has also been decided to save time and optimize the volume of waste to be transported, since the waste collected in the secondary transportation by trucks will be transferred at suitable places in to a vehicle mounted compactors that will transport the waste to dump yard or transfer station as per local conditions. In this context the PMU set up for implementation of G.O.Ms.279 has assessed the number of Vehicle Mounted Compactors required for 53 ULBs which are in 10 clusters formed for establishment of Waste to Energy Plants as Category 1 ULBs and 57 ULBs where Municipal Solid Waste Management plants are proposed to be set up as Category 2 ULBs and the details may be seen in table at para 2 ULBs and furnished the details.

- 3. The Managing Director, Swachh Andhra Corporation has further informed that the Director of Municipal Administration, A.P. Guntur requested to consider and examine the No. of Compactors required for 110 ULBs and Mechanical Sweeping Machines in 12 ULBs as informed by the PMU and arrange to provide Vehicle Mounted Compactors to all 110 ULBs and Mechanical Sweeping Machines in 12 ULBs for effective handling of the sanitation and SWM in the ULBs.
- 4. As requested by the Director of Municipal Administration, Swachha Andhra Corporation has proposed to procure the Mechanical Sweeping Machines and Vehicle Mounted Compactors to the ULBs and the details have been furnished.
- 5. Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Managing Director, Swachh Andhra Corporation, have accepted the same. Accordingly, Government hereby accord administrative sanction:
  - a) to procure the following Solid Waste Management Vehicles under SBM Funds released towards Solid Waste Management component for FY 2016-17 by Government of India.
    - 1. 6.50 Cum capacity Mechanical Sweeping Machines to 12 ULBs Rs. 28.50 Cr.
    - 2. 14 Cum capacity Truck Mounted Compactors to 110 ULBs- Rs. 53.60 Cr.
  - b) Consideration for according Technical sanction by the Chief Engineer (Public Health), Engineering Department.
  - c) Permitting the Managing Director, Swachha Andhra Corporation to procure all Vehicles, Machinery etc. required for all ULBs.
  - d) Permitting the CE (SAC) for issuing tenders notice and also for concluding agreements after issue of LOA by CE(SAC) with the qualified lowest tenderer for procurement of Vehicles, Machinery etc.
  - e) Constitution of Technical Evaluation Committee for technical evaluation of Tenders.
- 6. Further Government hereby constitute the Technical Evaluation Committee with the following for technical evaluation:

1. Chief Engineer , PH - Member 2. Chief Engineer , GVMC - Member

3. Chief Engineer , VMC - Member

Government also constitute the Tender Committee with the following

for approval of Tenders.

8. The expenditure shall be met by Managing Director, Swachh Andhra Corporation from solid waste management funds under Swachh Bharat Mission.
