Dear Sir/Madam

While hearing a petition on the bad condition of public toilets in Delhi, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi has made observations regarding non-mechanized cleaning of sanitary latrines in Delhi and non-identification of manual scavengers. Hon'ble High Court has further observed that absence of mechanized cleaning of sanitary toilets leads to need for manual scavengers. As such these manual scavengers need to be identified.

I would, therefore, request you to look into the issue and arrange to send the following information (in each ULB) immediately:

- (i) Number of sanitary toilets in the State with mechanized system of cleaning;
- (ii) Number of sanitary toilets cleaned by the manual scavengers
- (iii) Number of manual scavengers identified in the State,
- (iv) Deadline by which the manual scavenging will be eradicated in the state; and
- (v) Measures taken for the rehabilitation of the manual scavengers.
