

**GIST OF DISCUSSIONS DURING VIDEO CONFERENCE BY HON'BLE CHIEF MINISTER
ON 27/10/2017, 3:00 PM-6:00 PM ON SWACHHA ANDHRA MISSION**

Spl. Chief Secretary, PR&RD, RWS&S briefed the Hon'ble Chief Minister on the status of construction of toilets under SBM and action plan to achieve ODF by 31st March 2018.

General issues raised by the District Collectors:

1. Though specific instructions are issued involving District Level Officials in ODF program, some of the Departmental Officials are not giving importance to this program to the expected level. Directions from the State Level concerned HODs may be issued to all the field level functionaries.
2. Respective Heads of Departments may also keep construction of IHHLs as one of their agenda items in their regular reviews.
3. Many of the Public Representatives especially Gram Panchayat ward members, Sarpanches, Panchayat Secretaries, all PR representatives etc., doesn't have IHHL.

BEST PRACTICES BY DIFFERENT DISTRICTS:

1. Delegation of power of sanctioning of IHHLs to the MPDOs as was done by the District Collector, Visakhapatnam.
2. Identification of contractors and assigning villages to the contractors for construction of IHHLs will enable speedy construction.
3. Every day Swachhta Pledge by the students at the time of morning prayer will bring in behavioural change in the students. Obtaining consent letters from the parents of the school children who doesn't have toilets in their house.
4. While taking attendance of the students, students who have/doesn't have toilets at their house is also marked. This will make students those who doesn't have toilet in their house to force their parents for construction of a toilet.
5. Construction community toilet blocks to the beneficiaries where ever space for construction of toilet is not available and assigning each toilet block to one family for better maintenance.
6. Involvement of Sarpanches , other Public Representatives in construction of IHHLs and motivating the Public through local Brand Ambassadors like Karnam Malleswari.

INSTRUCTIONS BY THE HON'BLE CM:

1. Chief Secretary to Government to issue directions to all the Spl.CS/Prl. Secretaries/Secretaries/HODs in the State to ensure participation of respective field level functionaries in Swachhta Activities to achieve ODF by 31st March 2018.
2. Chief Secretary to Government to convene meeting with Spl. CS Education Department and Vice Chancellors of different Universities to work out the modalities on involving the Degree & PG students and awarding the marks in Swachha Andhra Mission covering ODF, Sanitation, Solid & Liquid waste management, Development of Greenery, Water Conservation, Social Responsibility etc.,
3. The Education Department shall come out with clear cut action plan on the above items by the next video conference and progress & action taken report shall be presented during the next video conference.
4. All the Vice Chancellors of the Universities shall attend to the fortnightly video conferences with the action taken reports.
5. The satisfaction level is 94% in respect of IHHLs in the survey conducted through 1100-Parishkara Vedika, however most of the beneficiaries doesn't have a valid mobile number or changed their numbers and the same need to be validated and updated by the districts.
6. Since only 5 months is left the construction activity has to be increased to construct atleast 4.00 Lakh toilets per month.
7. Out of 21.60 Lakh toilets to be constructed after purification of the data only 9.99 Lakh toilets are sanctioned, balance 11.60 Lakh toilets shall be sanctioned by end of this month.
8. All the items mentioned in the ODF action plan as per the check list shall be complied by all the districts by end of this month.
9. The toilet structure shall be named as "**Athmagowrawam Nilayam**" and all the structures shall be properly painted and decorated to give good aesthetic sense.
10. District wise ranking on different performance indicators as required by SBM(G) for National Ranking shall be presented during every video conference.
11. Endowment & Tourism Departments may include the Villages/Gram Panchayats who have done exemplary work in sanitation in their regular tourism circuits to spread the good practices create awareness.
12. Progress of construction of toilets to school children and women groups shall be closely monitored by Commissioner, School Education and CEO SERP.
13. The Commissioner, School Education shall finalize the monitoring of maintenance of school toilets through machine learning process.
14. Short film/Videos on the best practices and best performing GPs may be documented and shared with the Districts.
15. Best performing and Low performing Districts/Mandals/GPs under A,B,C,D categories may be analysed and presented during the next video conference.
16. The next video conference will be held on 10/11/2017 from 3:00 PM onwards.

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
