

**GIST OF DISCUSSIONS DURING VIDEO CONFERENCE
BY HON'BLE CHIEF MINISTER ON 14/11/2017, 4:00
PM-6:00 PM ON SWACHHA ANDHRA MISSION**

Principal Secretary, PR&RD, RWS&S briefed the Hon'ble Chief Minister on the status of construction of toilets under SBM and action plan to achieve ODF by 31st March 2018.

1. Education department to complete matching and batching of the students and villages by next video conference using the website and mobile app developed by SAC.
2. Education department to issue guidelines to all the district collectors and vice chancellors on adoption of villages and matching and batching. Modalities for monitoring and awarding the marks (both for project work and field work) to the students shall be worked out.
3. Since only 140 days is left, District wise, Mandal wise and Village wise targets shall be worked and the pace of the implementation shall be closely monitored.
4. The District collectors shall complete purification of data and updation in IMIS by next video conference. Purification of data and village wise targets shall be finalized by 30th November.
5. Quality of construction shall also to be ensured and monitored. Common mistakes during construction of IHHLs may be compiled and communicated to all the Districts.
6. SAC to work with E&Y and e-Pragati to finalize the beneficiaries not having the IHHLs and clean up any duplicate entries using machine learning techniques.
7. SAC to institute Innovation & Knowledge center to guide the districts on best practices, IEC & BCC, toilet technologies, solid and liquid waste management.
8. District wise dash-boards shall be developed by SAC so that districts can monitor the progress and also their position w.r.t other districts in the National wide ranking.
9. Third party verification agencies for verification of ODF may be appointed by SAC to ensure ODF sustainence.
10. Additional amount of Rs 3000/- in tribal areas and to the beneficiaries with disability may be worked out by SAC and necessary instructions may be communicated to the districts. Wherever additional amount is required for construction of IHHLs, the districts may explore CSR funds and SDF funds available with the districts.
11. The districts which have already achieved ODF shall now work on ODF sustainence, ODF+, Solid and Liquid Waste Management.
12. In ODF districts, Swachhagrahis shall focus on sustainence of ODF

and "Nigha Committees", Sanitation Wistle blowers etc,. shall be constituted to ensure ODF. Each GP shall have a special officer who will be taking care of ODF sustenance and ODF+ activities.

13. Innovative initiatives like " Tea with the District Collector", "SwachhAnthem similar to National Anthem", "Swachha Sena Parade on 26th January" may be adopted by the districts to bring awareness and motivate the public and natural leaders.
14. Districts which are already declared ODF viz., West Godavari, SPS Nellore and Krishna shall focus on ODF sustenance and ODF+.
15. Next Video Conference will be on 30th November.
16. Following instructions and timelines are fixed for the districts.
 - Guntur, Prakasam and East Godavari shall complete the target by 15th December 2017 and declare the district ODF.
 - YSR Kadapa to declare district ODF by 31st January 2018.
 - Vizianagaram, Kurnool, Visakhapatnam shall complete construction by 15th February 2018 and declare district ODF.
 - Chittoor, Srikakulam and Anantapuramu shall declare district ODF by 31st March 2018.
