

**GIST OF DISCUSSIONS DURING VIDEO CONFERENCE BY HON'BLE CHIEF MINISTER ON  
11/10/2017 3:00 PM-6:00 PM ON SWACHHA ANDHRA MISSION**

Prl. Secretary, PR&RD, RWS&S briefed the Hon'ble Chief Minister on the status of construction of toilets under SBM and action plan to achieve ODF by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018.

**GENERAL ISSUES RAISED:**

1. Delay in making Payments to the beneficiaries.
2. No provision for off-line geo-tagging of the IHHL using the m-SBM mobile application developed by NIC MoDWS.
3. To fill up the vacant post of SE RWS Visakhapatnam District.
4. Higher cost of construction in Tribal areas and difficulty in mobilization of material.
5. NBA pending payments to be cleared immediately.
6. The beneficiaries under NTR Housing scheme are not constructing the IHHL's along with construction of the house.
7. Most of the village level public representatives and functionaries does not have access to toilet.
8. Many of the government offices does not have toilets for the persons working and to the public visiting the offices.
9. About 29,000 schools require additional toilets/new toilets.
10. IHHLs constructed under previous schemes but become defunct.

**BEST PRACTICES BY DIFFERENT DISTRICTS:**

1. Appointment of Mandal level, Constituency level Special officers.
2. Involving Public representatives in motivation and implementation.
3. Assigning 10 to 15 IHHL beneficiaries to village level functionaries.
4. College , Degree students to stay in villages for 3 days to motivate, complete the grounding of IHHLs. Students to visit the above villages once in a week for three consecutive weeks and ensure completion of the toilet.
5. Sr. MPDO at District Level to sort out issues relating to e-FMS, IMIS, Geo-tagging, Aadhar, Material Procurement, Masons requirement may be nominated.
6. Constitution of vigilance teams to observe the ODF sustenance in the GPs already declared ODF.
7. Involvement of natural leader where ever elected public representatives are not effective.
8. Construction of Anganwadi centres as done in Chittoor District.
9. Construction of Anganwadi toilets using District Mineral Fund.
10. Triggering activities, Songs on ODF, Declaration of Athmagowrawam Day and creation of Athmagowrawam cell, regular meetings.
11. Identification of contractors already doing works under different Government programs in the Districts.
12. Ensuring construction of toilet along with construction of house.
13. All the Government Officers in the District to construct toilets for officers working and to the public visiting offices.
14. Divisional level meetings duly involving Sarpanches who have done exemplary work on sanitation.
15. Assistance from Sri Nidhi to the members of SHG groups to take up construction of IHHL.

16. School Children to motivate their parents for construction of IHHLs and obtaining consent letter from the parents.
17. Involving Brand Ambassadors.
18. Providing running water in schools duly meeting the expenditure from CSR component.
19. Identification of bulk material suppliers at District Level.

**INSTRUCTIONS BY HON'BLE CM:**

1. All the District Collectors to take action to declare State as ODF as per timelines already communicated.
2. Involving students of IX and X in Swachhta activities. College and Degree students to prepare project work.
3. The School Education Department shall ensure proper maintenance of the school toilets and regular feedback on usage and maintenance of the toilets.
4. The Education Department to workout modalities on awarding 5% of the marks to the students who are participating in Swachhta activities like Plantation, Sanitation, ODF, Road safety etc.,
5. All the Government offices at all levels shall have toilets, special focus on construction of public toilets shall be given in respect of institutions like APSRTC, Temples, Market yards, Rythu Bazars, Hospitals etc.,
6. Clear cut targets to different functionaries, fixing accountability and responsibility, establishing different hierarchy levels to be done.
7. Sr. MPDO to be appointed at District Level to resolve the technical issues and to coordinate between different Departments.
8. In tribal areas to meet the additional cost, District Collectors may explore possibility of meeting the expenditure through CSR mobilization/TSP.
9. PR & RD Department to fill up all the existing vacancies.
10. Software related problems to be attended on priority by SAC.
11. School toilets shall be treated as community toilets and to take up the construction as per norms of SBM.
12. All Districts to launch the campaign "Athmagowrawam" on a mission mode.
13. Involving Brand Ambassadors, Identifying champion sarpanches at District Level for motivating OD villages.
14. IEC material like songs, literature, Books like "Malligani Marugu Doddi" etc., to be compiled by SAC and communicate to all the Districts.
15. There shall not be any delay in release of payments to IHHLs.
16. 1100 Parikshara Vedika to assist the beneficiaries in redressing grievances relating to IHHLs. RTG to take necessary action.
17. Every district to constitute vigilance teams to ensure quality of materials and construction.
18. Construction of Anganwadi centres to be taken up on similar lines as was done in Chittoor District.
19. SAC to identify best practices and organize exposure visits.
20. Best practices and technologies in liquid waste management to be studied and demonstration projects to be taken up on pilot basis.
21. Instituting awards and felicitating the best performers.
22. SAC may appoint suitable agency to document the entire process of ODF declaration by the State by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018.
23. Next video conference to be conducted on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2017 from 03:00 PM onwards and all the officers shall attend without fail.
