Attention is invited to the subject and reference cited.

Vide reference cited, the Joint Secretary, SBM(G), Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation has informed that MoDWS has provisionally approved proposals for providing financial incentive to build toilets for eligible (as per the SBM-G guidelines) households which were left out of the baseline (LoB) survey and do not have a toilet. As a part of the regular due diligence done by MoDWS, officers who visited the field found that in some Districts, the LoB proposals included households which already had a toilet which they had built themselves or had received a financial support for the toilet from other programmes or through CSR.

It is reiterated that the MoDWS has accepted the LoB proposals only to support eligible households that do not have access to any toilet at present. It is advised to enter names of only those households in the IMIS who were left out of the baseline survey and do not have access to a toilet, and they have not been provided financial support from any other programme or scheme for toilet. No household that has already built a toilet should be entered in the LoB list. The MoDWS will also undertake a sample survey to ascertain that only genuinely left out of baseline households are granted assistance.

Therefore, it is requested to issue necessary instructions to the concerned to ensure that details of only genuinely left out households from baseline survey are entered in the IMIS and considered for assistance from SBM (G).


2. You are aware that this Ministry has provisionally approved proposals from States for providing financial incentive to build toilets for eligible (as per the SBM-G guidelines) households which were left out of the baseline (LoB) survey and do not have a toilet. As a part of the regular due diligence done by this Ministry, officers who visited the field found that in some Districts, the LoB proposals included households which already had a toilet which they had built themselves, or had received a financial support for the toilet from other programmes or through CSR.

3. It is reiterated that the Ministry has accepted the LoB proposals only to support eligible households that do not have access to any toilet at present. States are advised to enter names of only those households in the IMIS who were left out of the baseline survey and do not have access to a toilet, and they have not been provided financial support from any other programme or scheme for toilet. No household that has already built a toilet should be entered in the LoB list.
