Please refer my DO letter of even number dated 9<sup>th</sup> February, 2018, wherein the States were advised to ensure that all the villages in States undertake the self-assessment and report the same on IMIS.

2. The proposed issue of Village Swachhata Index (VSI) has been reviewed and it has been found that the current status of the villages which have so far reported the self-assessment is 66.5%, only. In this regard, the state-wise status may be seen at the Annexure-I for ready reference. I am very glad to note that many States have shown remarkable improvement in conducting the self-assessment, but more needs to be done.

3. In view of the above, I would like to request you to kindly review this issue in consultation with the concerned department/official on priority and ensure that all the villages in your State undertake the self-assessment and report the same on the IMIS, latest by 31<sup>th</sup> March, 2018.
