Ref: No. 5-17011/1/2020-SBM-DDWS, dt:17.09.2020, of the Under Secretary to the Government, SBM(G), Ministry of Jai Shakti Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation.

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Attention is invited to the subject and reference cited.

In the reference cited, the Under Secretary to the Government, SBM(G), Ministry of Jai Shakti Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation has informed that Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) Phase-II envisages on ODF sustainability and Solid and Liquid Waste Management in the villages. In order to ensure that no one is left behind in having access to toilet, all the new households shall be supported by the Gram Panchayats to construct their individual household latrines (IHHLs) so that sustainability of ODF status can be maintained.

Under the programme, there is a provision of incentive upto Rs.12,000 for construction of IHI-ILs in the new eligible households. In this regard, it is clarified that for providing incentive to the new eligible households, the details of the households alongwith Aadhaar no. are required to entered IMIS of SBM(G) maintained by this Department. Any households for which the details are not entered in IMIS, cannot be provided incentive under the programme.

While the details of community assets will be captured through the newly developed mobile app, details of new households will be continued to be entered by using IMIS of SBM(G). To facilitate the States to enter the details of new households, a module in IMIS is being developed by NIC of this Department which will be available to the States shortly. The States/UTs will be able to enter the details of new households in the IMIS upto 31st October, 2020 by using the new module. From 2021 onwards, the module for entering the details of new households will be opened twice a year in the months of April and October.

In view of above, all the States/UTs are requested to keep the data of all the new households ready so that entry of the details can be completed within the prescribed timeline.

Therefore, all the District Collectors are requested to issue necessary instructions to the SEs, RWS & S to take further necessary action in the above matter.


