Attention is invited to the subject and reference cited and please find the enclosed copy of the reference cited.

Vide reference cited, the Addl. Secretary (SBM), Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation has informed that it has been observed during various meetings/workshops with the States that though the States/UTs have almost completed their target of 100% sanitation coverage but they have not paid incentive to a large number of eligible beneficiaries under the programme. MoDWS has also requested the States/UTs to complete the construction of IHHLs in remaining Left out of Baseline households and for those using shared and community toilets as well, by 31st July, 2019. But, in most of the States, the pace of construction of such IHHLs has been slow. This needs to be geared up to complete the construction by stipulated timeline. The proposal for continuation of the programme beyond 2nd October, 2019 will envisage coverage of any incremental changes only that would occur after 2nd October, 2019 and ODF plus activities (i.e. sustainability of ODF status and Solid and Liquid Waste Management).

In view of above, the SEs RWS, are required to discharge the Government's liability towards payment of incentive for all eligible IHHLs including for Left out of Baseline households and those using shared and community toilets as well, at the earliest.

Therefore, it is requested to take necessary action for clearing the pending payments if any for eligible beneficiaries immediately.

Subject: - To ensure discharge of committed liability on account of incentive payment for Individual Household Latrines (IHHLs) constructed/to be constructed by 2nd October, 2019 under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) [SBM(G)] latest by 31st December, 2019– reg.

Madam/Sir,

As you are aware, the first phase of SBM(G) will come to an end on 2nd October, 2019. During the past five years, the States/UTs have made exemplary progress under SBM(G) and the sanitation coverage in the country have reached above 99%. However, it has been observed during various meetings/workshops with the States that though the States/UTs have almost completed their target of 100% sanitation coverage but have not paid incentive to a large number of eligible beneficiaries under the programme. This Department has also requested the States/UTs to complete the construction of IHHLs in remaining Leftout of Baseline households and for those using shared and community toilets as well, by 31st July, 2019. But, in most of the States, the pace of construction of such IHHLs has been slow. This needs to be geared up to complete the construction by stipulated timeline. The proposal for continuation of the programme beyond 2nd October, 2019 will envisage coverage of any incremental changes only that would occur after 2nd October, 2019 and ODF plus activities (i.e. sustainability of ODF status and Solid and Liquid Waste Management).

2. In view of above, the States are required to discharge the Government's liability towards payment of incentive for all eligible IHHLs including for Leftout of Baseline households and those using shared and community toilets as well, at the earliest.

3. Hence, it has been decided by this Department that all the States/UTs have to submit their claims for the Central share of committed liability for all the eligible IHHLs including LOB households, to the GoI **before 31st October, 2019** and make the payments to all the beneficiaries latest by 31st December, 2019. It is also intimated that no funds will be provided to the States/UTs after 31st December, 2019 by the GoI in this regard.
