Sub: SAC - Instructions for incentive amount released to beneficiaries towards construction of IHHLs under SBM (G) & PMAY schemes- Communicated - Reg.

Ref: D.O.No.S-18011/14/2017-SBM, dt:20.04.2018, of the Joint Secretary, SBM(G), Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation (MoDWS).

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Attention is invited to the subject and reference cited and also find the enclosed attachment.

Vide reference cited, the Joint Secretary, SBM(G), Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation (MoDWS) has informed that SBM-G funding (Center and State) is being used to provide incentive for toilets to the eligible beneficiaries as per BLS data entered in the IMIS of MDWS so that ODF villages and districts can be achieved on priority. Additionally, the Ministry of Rural Development is also financing the incentive for toilets being built under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY), and in 50,000 Antyodaya Gram Panchayats.

In view of the above, it is requested to follow the below instructions scrupulously for avoiding double payment to beneficiaries towards construction of toilets under SBM(G) and PMAY schemes.

1. Incentives for toilet to a PMAY beneficiary is given from SBM(G) only, if his or her name appears in the BLS of SBM(G).
2. If the PMAY beneficiaries name does not figure in the BLS of SBM(G) then the incentive for toilet be given only from MGNREGS.
3. Toilets built under MGNREGS whether under PMAY or otherwise, are also entered in SBM(G), IMIS, apart from its entry in IMIS of concerned Ministries.
4. Toilets built by households through their own investment or from any alternative sources be also reflected in the appropriate module of SBM(G), IMIS.

Therefore, it is requested to issue necessary instructions to the concerned to go through the contents of the letter and follow the instructions scrupulously during providing incentives to the PMAY & SBM(G) beneficiaries.



Dear Sir Madam,

As you are aware, the Government of India is according highest priority to achieving universal sanitation coverage in the country. With this in mind, the Swachh Bharat Mission-Gramin (SBM-G) was launched on 2nd October 2014 with the primary objective of making India Open Defecation Free (ODF) by 2nd October 2019. Good progress has been made by the States and rural sanitation coverage in the country has increased from 39% at the start of the Mission in October, 2014 to more than 82% as on date.

2. SBM-G funding (Centre and State) is being used to provide incentive for toilets to the eligible beneficiaries as per Base Line Survey data entered in the IMIS of MDWS so that ODF villages and districts can be achieved on priority. Additionally, the Ministry of Rural Development is also financing the incentive for toilets being built under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY), and in 50,000 Antyodaya Gram Panchayats.

3. However, it has been reported that in some States toilets in PMAY houses are being funded from both the schemes of MGNREGS and SBM-G. In such a case it is possible that PMAY beneficiaries in those States may get double payment for toilets. This can be on account of one member of the household getting benefit of a house under PMAY along with a toilet from SBM-G (whose name does not figure in the SBM-G baseline survey) and another member of same household getting it on account of his or her name figuring in the Baseline Survey of SBM-G. Two members of the same family getting incentive for toilets under SBM-G is not permissible as per the Government guidelines.

4. It is also observed that the toilets constructed through self-financing are not getting reflected in the overall report of the States/UTs, which means overall progress is under-reported.

5. Therefore, it may kindly be ensured that:

- Incentives for toilet to a PMAY beneficiary is given from SBM-G only, if his or her name appears in the BLS of SBM-G.
- If the PMAY beneficiary's name does not figure in the BLS of SBM-G then the incentive for toilet be given only from MGNREGS.
- Toilets built under MGNREGS whether under PMAY or otherwise, are also entered in SBM-G IMIS, apart from its entry in MIS of concerned Ministries.
- Toilets built by Households through their own investment or from any alternate sources be also reflected in the appropriate module of SBM-G, IMIS.
