**ORDER:**

The Government of India have taken up the Swachh Bharat Mission with a view to make all Indian Cities and towns totally sanitized, healthy and livable to derive Public Health and Environmental outcomes for all citizens with special focus on hygienic and affordable sanitation. Accordingly, Govt of AP has established Swachha Andhra Corporation which was incorporated from 1st May 2015 with a goal to achieve the campaign "Swachh Bharat Mission" launched on 2nd October 2014 by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India and orders issued in the reference read above. The Swachha Andhra Corporation has the mandate to fulfil the Mahatma Gandhi's dream of "Swachh Bharat" by eliminating open defecation, eradication of manual scavenging, Solid and Liquid Waste Management, Information, Education and Communication and Capacity Building activities to maintain the cleanliness and hygiene in urban and rural areas of Andhra Pradesh.

2. The Swachha Andhra Corporation established in the GO read above is initially for effective implementation of the components of SWachh Bharat Mission in urban local bodies in AP including the activities of Individual Sanitary Latrine scheme and solid waste management. Swachh Andhra Corporation is taking up the activities of construction of individual Household Toilets, Community Toilets and Public Toilets, scientific processing and disposal of municipal Solid waste, waste to energy projects and waste to compost projects are taken up under public private partnership.

3. The State Water and Sanitation Mission (SWSM) under the hood of Rural Water Supply and Sanitation(RWS&S) Department has been the implementing agency for construction of IHHLs and Community Sanitary Complexes in Rural areas Under Sanitation programme and the same is being implemented by the state under CSS with different names. Presently, it is being implemented as Swachh Bharat Mission – Gramin (SBM-G) comprehensively with focus on achieving Open Defecation Free (ODF) status in all Gram Panchayats besides other Sanitation components for Solid and Liquid Waste Management (SLWM). It is estimated that about 90 lakh IHHLs need to be constructed in the State to achieving Open Defecation Free (ODF) status in all Grama Panchayats. So far, 44.20 Lakh IHHLs are constructed i.e., 49% of households are having IHHLs and still 45.80 Lakh IHHLs are to be constructed to cover the entire state and declare the state ODF. It is targeted to achieve this task by October 2019.

4. Presently, the Rural Water Supply & Sanitation (RWS&S) Department is managing the programme which has only one functionary at Mandal level, i.e., AE/AEE. Besides the sanitation (IHHLs), the AE/ AEE, RWS & S has multi tasks of

supervising construction of Drinking Water Supply Schemes, Projects and inspection, advising and providing technical assistance to the Gram Panchayats, Mandal Parishads and Zilla Parishads on O&M of SVS, Hand Pumps and CPWS Schemes. Hence, it will be a herculean task for the RWS & S to achieve the above target of constructing 45.80 lakh toilets qualitatively and implement the programme effectively.

5. Accordingly Government have decided and hereby transfer the subject of "Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin)" from Rural Water Supply and Sanitation Department to Swachha Andhra Corporation for effective implementation of SBM. The SBM shall be implemented with the following structure for better pooling of funds, implementation and to achieve the goal and get expected outcomes of sanitation and hygiene at household and habitation level. The Project Director, SBM ( Rural) shall continue to work with Mission Director, Swachh Andhra Corporation for implementation of SBM (rural ). The EFMs shall continue for financial transactions.
