Video Conference on ODF Action Plan

Present Status

- No. of households without toilets as per BLS -2012 - 48.20 Lakh
- No. of toilets constructed under SBM - 20.00 Lakh
- No. of toilets to be constructed after purification of data - 21.60 Lakh
- Total no. of Gram Panchayats - 12,854
- No. of Gram Panchayats declared ODF - 4,600
- Balance to be declared ODF - 8,254
- No. of Districts declared ODF so far - 3 Nos(West Godavari, Nellore, & Krishna)
- Districts to be declared ODF by November 2017 - Guntur(91,131) , East Godavari(48,236)
- Districts to be declared ODF by March 2018 - Ananthapur, Chittoor, Kadapa , Kurnool, Prakasam, Srikakulam, Visakhapatnam, Vizianagaram.
- About 21.60 Lakh IHHLs need to be constructed covering 8,254 GPs and 10 Districts to declare State ODF by 31st March 2018.
- Weekly targets are 96,000 IHHLs and 373 GP.
- Daily targets are 13,714 IHHLs and 53 GPs.

ODF Action Plan

- Focused target groups not having IHHLs viz., School Children, SHG groups, Shrama Shakti groups, Elected and Non Elected members of Panchayat Raj Institutions shall be the priority.
- 3.56 Lakh Students are not having IHHLs in their houses.
- 6.50 Lakh SHG members are not having IHHLs in their houses.
- District Collectors shall prepare village level action plan on grounding & completion.
- Procurement of Bricks/RR stone, RCC rings, Cement, Sand, Pan, Roof material, Door Shutters, P Trap and RCC pit covers shall be planned in advance.
- In case of construction by individual material availability at their door step shall be ensure.
- District Level Purchase committee to finalize the Prices and Agencies.
- Contractors/NGOs/VOs etc., GP wise to be identified to take up construction activity.
- Training to the Masons shall be organized at Mandal Level.
- Only BIS quality material shall be used and standardization of specifications for the material to be done at District Level.
- Only twin pit toilet/Septic tank shall be allowed.
- Publicity on 1100 call center for redressal of IHHL grievances.
- Gram Panchayat, JBMV committee shall be responsible for implementation of this program.
- Respective Departments shall be responsible in respect of their respective Focused Groups.
- Brand Ambassadors will be extensively involved in this program.
- Students of IX and X standards, all UG & PG students shall be involved in this program either individually or in groups.
- Education Department will award 5% marks for the students participating in SAM activities.
- Indian Red Cross Society, Youth Red Cross Society, Jr. Red Cross Society, AP National Green Corps, National Cadet Corp, Bharat Scouts and Guide, PET and YOGA etc., shall be involved.
- One Sr. MPDO as Nodal Officer to attend issues on e-FMS, IMIS, Geo-tagging and Aadhar may be appointed.
- Vigilance teams at District Level to check Quality of material and Quality of construction may be constituted.
